Dear Paola,

We have continued to thank you for sending us Gentili's book on stamps in Syracuse, as we have gradually added its new information to our files.

Most important are the pairs of Rhodian eponyms and fabricants, especially those on whole jars, but also those on handles from jars broken in a tomb. We would be very grateful for rubbings of all these pairs of stamps. In case this is permitted, and there is somebody who will find time to make the rubbings, I enclose some papers suitable for this purpose, also a few samples. The little paper is to be held very firm over a stamp, and with a finger of the other hand one must rub powdered graphiti (pencil-point shavings will do) over the paper which is firmly over the stamp. (If the paper moves, the rubbing will be "flow".) We would be glad to have rubbings of all the pairs of stamps published on pp. 34-37 of Gentili's book. But in case there is no time for such a job, do please send us rubbings of the following:

- p. 34, no. 4
- p. 36, no. 14
- p. 36 no. 19
- p. 37, no. 21
- p. 37, no. 22

In each case, we need rubbings of both stamps of a pair, even if one of the stamps seems illegible. Of this special list, if possible please send us two rubbings of each stamp, to help with reading.
