Dear M. Masson,

Thank you for your note of June 14.

The reading AKANAPIAA evidently comes from readings in Dumont (1871), cf. his p.147, nos. 29 and 30. The first line is followed by *sic*. However, when it came to illustrating the type, the only drawing is no.13 in his ~~PLXIII~~ Pl.XII, which shows a stamp in which the top left is very dim. (The stamp drawings in this book are very careful and accurate.). It appears to me quite clear that AKANAPIAA is a wrong reading for K]AEANAPIAA. In our study of ~~the~~ the stamped amphora handles in the National Museum of Athens, which had taken in Dumont's material as a whole, we found 16 impressions of a stamp with the following reading:

ΕΠΙ ΚΑΕΑΝΑΠΙΑΑ  
ΑΠΙCΤΑΓΟΡΑ  
ΚΝΙΑΙΟΝ

In our numbering of Knidian stamp types, this one is KT 192; on the numbering, see EAD 27, p.323, or Hesperia 1985, p.14, note 28. The examples in the National Museum were of course by no means all completely preserved, but identifiable by the die. We found no example reading AKANAPIAA (*sic*).

From your kind remarks in BCH Suppl.13, p. 44, I know you have seen my published list of Knidian eponyms (Hesperia 1985, pp.32-34). So it would perhaps be easy to find out that we here do not believe in a Knidian eponym AKANAPIAAΣ, as he is not listed there. I enclose photocopies of photos of two examples <sup>(X)</sup> of KT 192; both are Delos finds; there seem to have been none in the National Museum superior enough to photograph for a published illustration of the type.

On Dec. 5, eight subtypes of this KT were isolated, by means of assembling the best examples of 366 in the EM drawers, and the photo. for other places in the KT photo. file. Since then, AA has sorted all the EM examples, and all the Agona examples, and MS has sorted post-campaign ABC subtypes, without any more subtypes being found than these 8; except that of the 8, no. 7 shows some further variation within itself; letters in exactly same relative positions (also same?) seem to have been rewritten, and some <sup>of the</sup> difficult examples not apparently belonging to any of the 8 types have not yet been identified outside KT 366 (though others have).

The various subtypes will be kept separate, marked I, II, III, etc. following in 366. AA has prepared <sup>master</sup> type cards for the subtypes, to match their picture cards assembled to make possible the sorting; Agona examples have been listed on these cards, and EM examples will be. The EM numbers will be <sup>those of</sup> the original unsorted 366 series - i.e. new EM nos. will not begin.

- I. Note small dot on or under side in the field, from one of which line of a slipped tool across the E of Δ.

It has been possible to identify more precisely 4 of those <sup>not</sup> called 366A: ABC 14 and 22 from KT 366, ABC 106-7; ABC 5 goes to KT 1478, and ABC 25 to KT 1434. <sup>These</sup> Numbers ABC 5, 15, 22, 25 have been reassigned to more recently identified 366A (for the case of illegible I think), which all have secondary stamps, see above. One more possible identification is KT 366A, ABC 14, with KT 1351, for the present, kept with KT 366A.

An ex. found in one of G.R.E.'s wells in Corinth, 530 of his abortive nos. of 1962, C 47-243, from Well XI, "Fill 1, Mummies... Contents dates, ca. 150 B.C."

Not necessary however to give a pre-146 date because of this context, since 2 duoviri kind appear in similar ("Mummies") fills from other wells (522 - C 48 55 from Well 9, and 531 - C 34-164 - from Well X) (and a late Ptolemaic from still another well (513 - C 34-163 - from Well VIII) — but I see Well VIII is called 128 AD, anyhow)

An ex., SS 13831, comes from a large good post-MSBF group in Section K, see list of Group 3 of them, w. lower limit approx. 3/4 of 2nd; there was however a lot of 188-167 with this. This is not of course a group endorsed by the excavator.

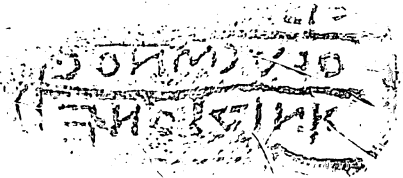

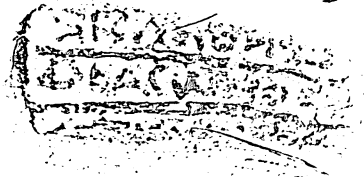

15.VI, our 4 (P 81): I have still no parallel for this object, which I suppose to be late Hellenistic.

12.IX, our 1 (P 115): Rhodian eponym ΑΒΞΤΡΑΤΟΞ, late in the first quarter of the 2nd century. See Pergamon XI, 1 (1968), p. 177, no. 14. Here he is dated late in a period there called 220-180 B.C. Relative date is still the same, but now I date the whole period a little later; it is that of the earlier Pergamon deposit discussed Delos 27, pp. 290-291.

12.IX, our 2 (P 118): this is Knidian T(type) 931, type of the Knidian fabricant ΚΥΠΡΟΞ in the term of the eponym ΚΡΥΣΙΝΗΟΞ, circular type with forepart of lion, the handle having also a secondary stamp with an alpha. On the fabricant, see Delos 27, especially p. 329, under E 72. On the eponym, see Hesperia Suppl. X, p. 156, no. 149. Note from these references that this fabricant, also several others who name this eponym, worked also at the beginning of the duoviri period of Knidian stamps, so the term of ΚΡΥΣΙΝΗΟΞ evidently fell shortly before the beginning of the duoviri period, to have so many fabricants overlap. The naming of duoviri seems to have begun about 108 B.C., cf. Delos 27, pp. 320-321.

I am sorry for these photos to have been delayed, but they were a small part of the film, not urgent, and the darkroom here always pressed. The other handle, the one from Rhodes, surface, turned out not to be on the film (which Andreas exposed, i.e. it fell between us). We'll do it on the next.

Do you know if Nicolas Coldstream has published something about the stamped handle(s?) which he found in Knossos, in 1966 or 1967? When either of you publishes such material, I would be glad to have notice of it, if an offprint is inconvenient.

This type is on a <sup>relatively</sup> wide jar from C 9:7, and this has been measured as to capacity by M.B. Wallace. I wished to give him dates for the measured jar. This type, which we have <sup>listed</sup> 15 examples, has not been fully read, because the part to the right of the dionis (on the dionis's right) is never well impressed, as shown not in any of the examples of which we have photos and/or rubbings. On the master card, there has been a suggestion to move the head a little to the right, to read Επι Δαίδα[δα]; next and I do not know if this is justified by some ex., say, in the National Museum, of which we do not have here a rubbing or a photo.

Δαίδαδος is not very much later than the first known epigraphy, Ἰθάππος and Ἐρωίππος (according to the unfinished grid in the bottom dionis of the drawing cabinet). Still, it would be the latest ep. in C 9:7 which is early dionis <sup>VI A</sup> piece and also late V. If we have ΔΑ as the 1st 2 letters of an epigraphic name, I would have to be Δαίδαδος or Δαυδοίππος, etc. And then does not seem to be room for a little Δαυδοίππος followed by a name. Don't feel entirely sure of ΔΑ. If it is Δαίδαδος, note we have no candidate for the dionis type (Ἀπίστῶρος - Ἐπαιτίδας).

The combination (A), on 2 handles attached to a nest (SS 9467), gives us <sup>the</sup> dvoiri that go with the sponges ΔΕΥΤΟΡΤΟΣ; ἈΡΙΟΤΣΑΣ and ΒΑΚΥΙΟΣ

(ἈΡΙΟΤΣΑΣ and ΒΑΚΥΙΟΣ)

These dvoiri, on KT 1884 allow us to connect KT 1884 with KT 1890, making the combination (B). It is a little odd that the two types don't leave the same device, but that is true also in the known combination A.

The combination (C), on 2 handles attached to the same jar, confirms the fact that two types, with different devices can appear at this period in Knidos on the same jar. It also gives us a new pair of dvoiri though not yet their whole names: ]ϛΘος[4α5]OKΔΥΣ. It attaches these dvoiri to an sponge [E<sup>3</sup>]ΒΟΥΔΟΣ: we guess it is this -ΒΟΥΔΟΣ because there is not much room, i.e. too little room for a longer name.

The combination (D) is another cluster type with four types, such as has been established by the jar of combination C (SS 9464). It attaches



The duoviri Δεξίφρυς and -άτης & the sponges Διορύκιδης. It gives us the fabricant, Ὀδοφρύς, probably & to be supplied in combinations B and C (because of the pair of types, cluster and prow).

The not-yet-combination **E** gives another type of Ὀδοφρύς with prow.

The combination **F** is another cluster type with prow type, such as has been established by the pair of combination C. It attests the duoviri Κερότιδος and Θε[ ] to an sponge [Ἄγαθο]βουδος. It gives us again the fabricant Ὀδοφρύς as fabricant of the prow and cluster types combined. Ἄγαθοβουδος is another sponge found in Period VII, like Εὐβουδος. As the duoviri are different, we can draw the same sponge in both types (KT 2268 and KT 2128). The longer name fits better in KT 2268.
