"Imitation Plurid"

MSIT has had this file, and recently - in connection with Απεδδάνιο, Πισίδας? or Kou names that appear on some of these "imitation"?

"Imitation Rhodian"

See EAD 27, under E 20, also pp. 280 and 363, on handles of Rh. shape but wrong clay.

Names that occur: They are Pergam^{see under E 20} dep. perist.

Ἐργασίος (see under E 20)

Δίος(see ~~also~~ p. 363

Another name on a handle of Rh. shape but non-Rh. clay is

Ποδίτυς (clay reported to us by Böcher, on a "Rh." handle in the Perg. deposit.)

[1.10.89 could be a kind Ποδίτυς of III-IV?]

Something has certainly been gathered about these names and this manifestation, but I cannot find a folder assembling it under RHODIAN. Check
→ with METI, perhaps she has it, as Kram.

See MISC. ASSIGNED. One of the 2 types under Hierapytnian (without ^{the one} BIRD) is on a very Rhodian-like handle (good photo) of which the clay is said to be "greenish". The name Σωσός (ΣΩΣΟΣ) which is not Rhodian but kind (of p. 363) appear on both types.

Some handles shaped like the 2nd cent. aigle Rhodian (no aigle preserved) and bearing in general Rhodian names, but the clay seems wrong.

Ἰδύμ[που] 600 (ετ')

[Χρυσίμου] 2880 (κ)

Κεφάλου 5561 (ε)

Seems to be a Δ before the α, which makes Ἀττάλου or Κεφαλάου Kiff.

600 may simply be an unsuccessful real Rhodian (not, but fine characteristic clay). The other two look almost like imitations

3 handle twisted things which are prob. not Rhodian

1936, 5260, 5933.

imitations ^{of late Rhodian} of Rhodian pots were still worth imitating

- all 8049 with wing spray
- 7430 with unrecognizable device

They may act. be Rhodian
